- Water bottle labelled with your child's name.

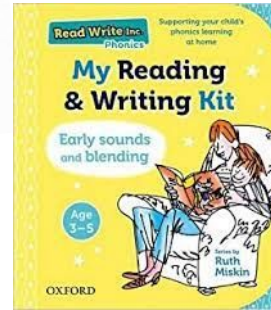
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# Swimming

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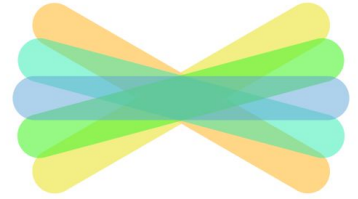
## Units of inquiry this year

- Seesaw is a learning journal that keeps track of your child's learning.
- It also allows you to contact with your child's teacher.
- Teachers will post every week to keep you updated of the activities that they will be doing.
- Feel free to like and comment on the posts.
- Great opportunity to talk about the school with your child.
- Teachers will not answer messages after school hours.
