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## Swimming

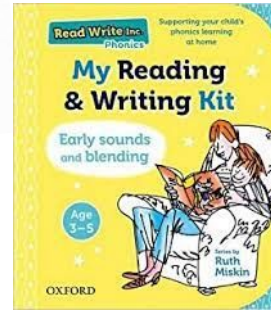
- Where? Penguins Bonanova

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## Units of inquiry this year

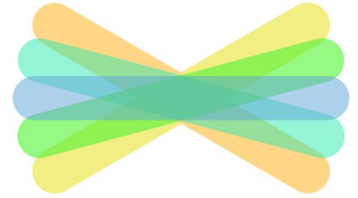
- Term 1: Who we are & Where we are in Space and time

- Great opportunity to talk about the school with your child.
