



20 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT AFTERSCHOOL ACTIVITIES

WHEN

1. When do the after-school activities start?

After-school activities start on the 18th of September. You can check the [after-school year calendar](#).

2. Between what times do the after-school activities run?

Our students from Y6 to Y12 will enjoy after-school activities from:

Foundation students: 4.30 to 5.45 pm

Primary students: 4.30 to 6 pm

Y6 - Y12 students: 4 pm to 5 pm

3. Why Foundation and Primary students do 1.30 h of after-school activities?

All students have 1 hour of afterschool activities. However, Foundation and Primary students will have between 15 min and 30 min to get changed and have a snack from home, before starting the afterschool activity. Our students will be always supervised by the afterschool teachers.

PICK UP TIME

4. When and where will we pick up our children at the end of the day?

Pick up time. Punctuality is requested.

Parents/guardian must pick up their children from the school at:

Foundation: 5.45 pm - Main entrance

PYP: 6 pm - Main entrance

MYP and Diploma: 5 pm - Main entrance

5. When is the latest time I can collect my child?

School closes at 6 pm and punctuality is requested. You should pick up your child no later than 6 pm.

TRIAL DAYS

6. Is there any chance to do a trial day?

Open Days will be held from 18th to 21st September. Registration needed. Families must send an email to afterschool@stpeters.es

7. After the trial day, is it too late to enrol my kid?

After the trial day, you can enrol your kid in the activity as long as there are available places. Please, send an email to afterschool@stpeters.es

ENROLMENT

8. Which is the enrolment deadline to register for an after-school activity?

The enrolment period started in July. In September, online enrolment open again only for those activities with available places. As places are limited, we suggest you register your child as soon as possible through our website.

9. Is it possible to register my child for a month, instead of a full semester?

Afterschool activities are offered on a semester basis. For organizational reasons, unfortunately, it is not possible to register for less than one semester.

10. Is it possible to register my child for only one day in a 2-day activity?

Between the wide offer, there are some 1-day activities like Chess, Art, Robotics, Spanish, etc. However, some other activities are designed as a 2-day activity because they require training, commitment and competition. Depending on the activity, we can study the case: your kid could come only one day paying full price.

11. Do we have to enrol again for the second semester?

No, the renewal is automatic at the end of each term or semester. Only new students need to register if they want to join any afterschool activity in the second semester.

PAYMENT

12. What are the payment methods available?

The after-school activities payment can be made by:

- Direct bank debit
- Card at the school reception
- Bank transfer

13. How is the payment managed?

Families can pay through bank account, direct debit or by card at the school reception (8.30 am to 4.30 pm).

The invoice for the after-school activities will be issued on a six-month basis, at the beginning of each semester (September and February) according to the payment method selected when enrolling.

14. Are there any discounted fees for siblings?

Exclusively, there is an early bird discount for those families who enrol before the 7th of July.

ABOUT THE ACTIVITIES

15. Will the activities be delivered in English or Spanish?

Our main language is English. However, some of the after-school activities are delivered in Spanish as we are working with other organisations to offer more activities. It would depend on the teacher.

16. Will all the after-school activities take place in the school?

All our activities in our programme will take place in the school with the exception of Swimming, an activity for Y1 & Y2 students that takes place at Penguins Betania.

17. Is there a minimum and maximum of students per activity?

Yes, we require a minimum of 6 students and a maximum of 15 (depending on the activity, even less).

18. Do students have to bring any specific equipment?

Yes, families and students will be informed about the specific material required for every activity. Also, students can bring their water bottle and their own daily snack. The school competition equipment for basketball, football and volleyball will be available shortly to buy at the school.

19. What is the daily procedure?

At the end of the day, instructors and teachers will pick up the children from their classes or dining room to go where the afterschool activity takes place. Foundation and Primary students will have time to get changed and have a snack before starting the activity. Secondary and Diploma students come to the activity by their own.

CHANGES/ CANCELLATIONS

20. Is there a cancellation policy?

By registering your child for afterschool activities, you accept the school's registration, cancellation and change policy.

The renewal is automatic at the end of each semester. Any changes or unenrollments must be requested within the time interval shown below -from the 22nd to 25th of January- and must be communicated by email to afterschool@stpeters.es

If for any special reason, if your child does not feel comfortable with the selected activity, please contact afterschool@stpeters.es and we can change the activity within the term, as long as there are places available. If despite the suggested changes you would like to unsubscribe, you would need to contact afterschool@stpeters.es and we will study the case.
