

1. What is Singularity Model United Nations

SMUN is an educational debate that fosters a distinctive environment where delegates are actively encouraged to think critically and reflect upon the implications of AI in shaping our future world. Emphasizing forward-thinking and innovation, it cultivates a platform for students to delve into discussions about emerging technologies, notably Artificial Intelligence (AI), and their connections to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

2. Dates and venue

The 8th edition of SMUN will be held from the 4th to 6th of April 2025 at St Peter's School Barcelona. The opening ceremony will be held at the Abat Oliba University. The rest of the sessions and debates will be held at St Peter's School.

3. Price

The price of the activity is 110€ per participant. This price includes the bus service, meals, social party and other resources provided throughout the duration of the simulation. Advisors are free of charge.

4. Accommodation

St Peter's School does not provide accommodation. However, we will make a pre-reservation at a nearby hotel and will arrange the rooms for you.

5. Registration process

- Interested schools may communicate by email (sginjaume@stpeters.es) their intention to participate at any moment, starting now and up to November 2024. At this point no specific information about participants is required.
- During November 2024 St. Peter's will send a link to a Google Forms that interested schools should complete by the end of November. In this form an estimation of the number of participants and advisors will be asked, as accurately as possible.

- During January 2025 St Peter's will ask schools to provide the final list of participants and advisors with their personal data.
- Inscription will be formalized once the payment is received which should be done by the end of March 2025.

6. Services

The school will provide various services to the participants, which are all included in the total price of the activity.

The services offered are as follows:

- Bus (all journeys included except from the airport/station to the hotel and from the school to the airport/station).
- Meals during the three days (breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack).
- Academic material such as videos of simulations, examples of position papers, rules of procedure, etc.
- Pedagogical and ludic activities for advisors.
- List of suggested afternoon activities in Barcelona for our international participants.
