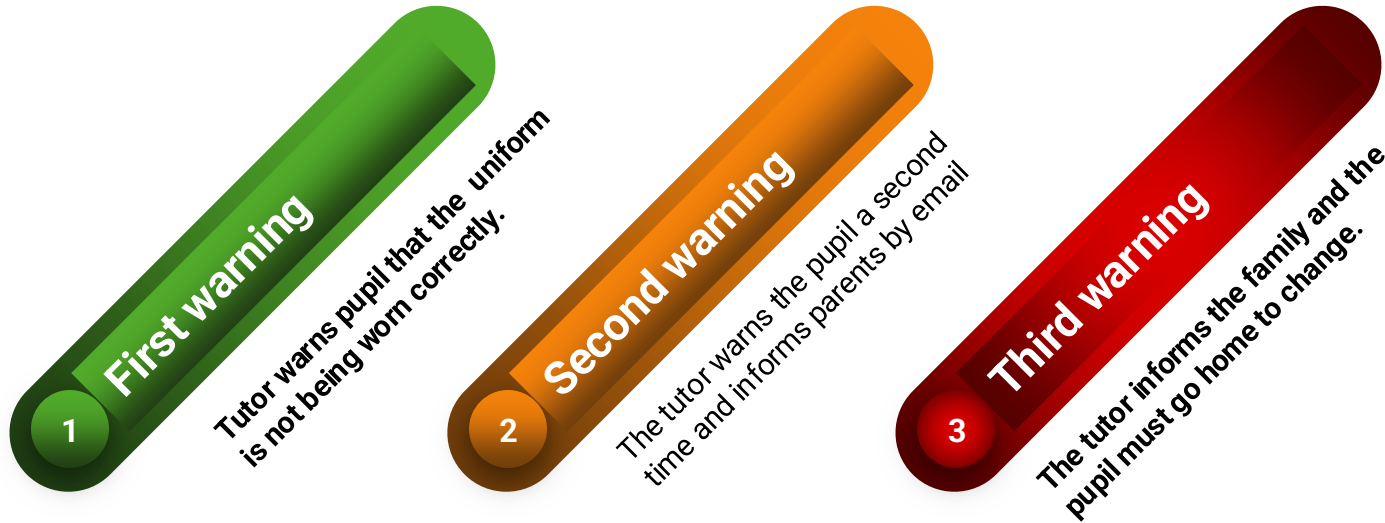
Late assignment policy

This policy outlines the consequences for students who fail to meet assigned deadlines for coursework or projects

1. Deadlines for assignments will be clearly communicated by the instructor in advance and posted on google classroom
2. Late assignments will not be accepted without prior approval from the instructor.
3. Approval to turn in a late assignment may be granted under exceptional circumstances:
 - a. Y6 can have extensions decided by each teacher under each of the circumstances
 - b. Y7 to Y10 deadlines are firm
 - c. New students can have an adjusting period
4. Unapproved late assignments will not be accepted and will receive a grade of zero. Tutors will be informed

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6.4 Clarifications regarding Uniform


- Pupils may only wear the P.E. uniform during P.E. classes.
- All students should shower after P.E. They will therefore need a bag with a change of clothes, shower gel, towel etc.
- A lab coat/overall must be worn for Science.
- Special uniforms for after-school activities should only be worn during those activities. Normal uniform should be worn at all other times.
- If a pupil has a problem with a particular item of school uniform, parents should inform school.
